BOLIVIA OVERWHELMINGLY WELCOMES REFORMATION



At the first Reformed Bolivian Convention, about 700 attended. Eighty pastors and others registered to study at the new Universidad Seminario Reformado Latinoamericano Bolivian Campus.

ANSWER TO QUESTIONS ABOUT MEDELLIN BUILDINGS



1. The buildings were purchased with contributions and loans from the USA. USRL now owns the buildings, but they serve as mortgage collateral.

2. The buildings are essential, as Medellin became the hub for Reformation in Latin America. The church/conference room building is at capacity. At the main campus, already more bunk beds are needed.

They cost \$80 dollars each.
