On several occasions, I have had the temptation to run away from this overwhelming responsibility and flee away from Nineveh, especially when the end of the month comes and we do not have sufficient funds to buy food for the seminarians or to pay bills. We experienced that difficulty this past month.

While I was at the bank to wire the meager amount left in the SRL account, I found out that exactly the needed funds had arrived to the bank the day before.

The moment I was sending the wire to Medellin, I received an e-mail from the SRL Seminary informing me that on that same day, SRL received over one hundred student registrations from many countries to matriculate for the new virtual semester online.

They also informed me that a number of professors were having a glorious time teaching many pastors in different countries at SRL sites. Please hold those teachers up in prayer and in gratitude to God for their services. For example, Dr. Thomas Woodward and Pastor Harry Stoliker went to Bolivia. Dr. Thomas Ascol, Dr. Don Kistler and Dr. James Bearss went to Colombia. Mr. Michael Delarm taught several Church History courses that are now on the web and are in great demand on the part of the students. The e-mail also announced the preparations for a large antiabortion conference at the Seminary campus where they would like to open a crisis pregnancy center in September. Pastors will be encouraged to do the same in their cities. The Sanford Crisis Pregnancy Center will participate. As I was writing this letter, Pastor Bill Heard from Mississippi also called regarding this effort.

When news like this is received in one day, especially on a day of some economic concerns, then what else could I do, but glorify God for the way He is using this poor mission to flood an entire continent with well-trained ministers of the gospel! This encourages me to continue to walk the path that HE has laid out for me and stay away from any hungry fish that would transport me to Nineveh, Colombia.
